## ANSWERS

Q1: The primary question is whether we can trust the BBC to give us an accurate, impartial, wide-ranging and searching portrayal of news events and issues both at home and abroad. The BBC is certainly technically equipped to do so, but the reality is that it consistently fails to deliver on most of the major issues, especially the most contentious ones which affect various key 'constituencies' - political, economic, scientific, medical and military. BBC news reporting is subject to endemic bias (cf. the Glasgow Media Group report: "Bad News from Israel") and failure to challenge routine disinformation coming from official sources - making the BBC de facto complicit in concealing the truth from the public. The suspicion is that it is too close to those constituencies and in effect a part of the establishment. It is clearly not independent of government influence.
