EPISODE TWO

Mel is rescued from the bubble by Ikona : Ikona wants to get their leader, Beyus, back and Mel is convinced that as the Doctor has been kidnapped, the enemy must be desperate for his help

Faroon discovers her daughter's skeleton and she goes to find her husband, Beyus : Urak, head of the Tetraps, guards the entrance to the lab and as he allows Faroon access, Ikona diverts his attention enabling Mel to enter

However, Mel is then spotted by Urak who gives chase: the Rani who has enlisted the Doctor's help has gone off in search of a suitable material for the repair of her machine, still disguised as Mel. Urak mistakenly ensnares her - while Mel and the Doctor at last meet and finally recognise each other

The Rani returns and realises the Doctor knows who she is : he then rushes off to the Eyrie where the Tetraps are fed by Beyus and hides from the Rani -

The episode ends with him being trapped between two of the Tetraps

EPISODE THREE

The Tetraps' attention is distracted from the Doctor as they go to feed: Beyus helps the Doctor to escape but is knocked over by him when he pinches the Microthermister

The Rani enters her laboratory, sees the damaged machine and sets off the alarm: Mel is captured by Urak and is 'tongued' - and the Doctor is confronted by a Tetrap which, when blinded by Ikona's weapon, falls into a trap and is killed. The Doctor and Ikona then enter the Centre of Leisure (where the lethargic Lakertyans come, and go freely) ignored by all including Lanisha, Ikona's own brother.

The Rani blames the Lakertyans for the death of the Tetrap and punishes Beyus' people by setting off a stampede of Fireflies in the Centre, killing several Lakertyans as well as Lanisha.

Faroon arrives with a message - the Rani will exchange Mel for the Microthermister: the meeting is set up and Urak collects the Microthermister - but the Doctor has been deceived! The target could be the asteroid of Strange Matter - if it's to be the Solstice, he must get back into the laboratory.

Meanwhile, in the laboratory, the machine is now fully operational but the increase in brain activity is not enough

Ikona once again diverts the Tetrap's attention to enable the Doctor to return - but this time, Urak is waiting: the unconscious Doctor is humped in and placed in the prepared cabinet. The Rani orders the stimulation to be increased so now they have his donation on stream.

The episode ends with Mel screaming and the Doctor convulsing in his cabinet
