Woodland animals

Watch the video clip to get some hints on how to;
Get the effect of black and white fur for the badger
Mix colours to paint your fox
Paint your hedgehog and give it some bristles

Painting a badger

- Using a paintbrush and white and black paint, get the effect of the badger's fur

Painting a fox

- Using the 3 primary colours, mix the shades of brown you need and paint your fox
- Use white paint for the fox's underbelly

Painting a hedgehog

- Using a sponge loaded with red, blue and yellow paint, sponge paint onto your hedgehog drawing using a dabbing motion
- Leave to dry then spread PVA glue on the top half of the hedgehog
- Sprinkle dried rice onto the sticky area
- Using a fine paintbrush and black paint, paint the hedgehog's eye, snout and claws
- Add a point of white to each eye to give a more life-like effect
