

BBC PROMS IN THE PARK

Gates open at 4.00pm, the entertainment starts at 5.30pm and the performance will end at approximately 10.30pm.

VENUE

In Hyde Park on a site running parallel to Park Lane from below Speaker's Corner towards the Serpentine. Entrances to the arena are all at the North (Marble Arch end) of the Park. There will be no additional parking for the event and the use of public transport is highly recommended. See below for information on disabled parking facilities. This is a picnic-style event with standing or sitting on the grass. With the exception of people with limited mobility please do not bring chairs as this obstructs the view of others. Make sure you bring plenty of sunscreen and something warm to wear in the evening – remember that even the sunniest day can turn chilly. The concert takes place on a greenfield site and the ground may be uneven. There will be ramps and temporary roadways. Please take care when walking on and off these roads and ramps or crossing them in wheelchairs.

GETTING THERE

The nearest underground stations are: Marble Arch, Hyde Park Corner and Knightsbridge. The following buses run past

DISABLED ACCESS

There will be a raised viewing platform with unreserved admission for wheelchair users and those needing seats. Disabled toilet facilities will be provided. If it is necessary to use chairs in other areas, please do so with consideration for others. There are disabled parking facilities on North Carriage Drive, restricted to current disabled permit-holders who have a valid ticket to the event. Entrance to North Carriage Drive is from Victoria Gate. An induction loop will be provided in part of the arena.

CHILDREN

There is no age restriction but unaccompanied children under the age of 14 will not be admitted.
