

Primary History: Romans

Extension Activity - Roads and Places

Find a map showing Roman sites in your area. Can you tell if the sites are the remains of forts, towns or villas? Check if there are any Roman-style place names near where you live. From this evidence can you decide what your area was like in Roman times?

Mosaics are pictures or patterns made up of many tiny squares of coloured stone or pottery. The Romans loved them. Look at some Roman mosaics, then **make a mosaic of your own** using squares of coloured paper.

Romans liked to eat seafood, even when they lived a long way from the sea. Many towns had seafood and fish shops. The site of a seafood shop has been found at Wroxeter. **Find out about this Roman town.** Was it close to the sea? Do you think Romans liked the seaside?
