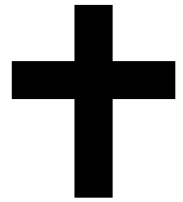


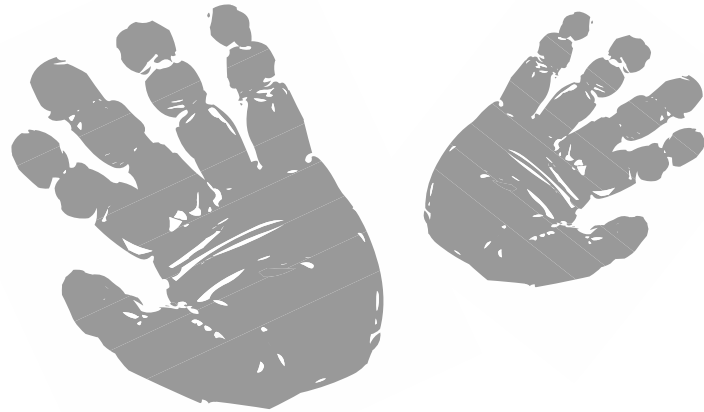
# Christianity — Easter

## How to make a handprint chick



### You will need:

White card  
Yellow paint  
Wobbly eyes  
Orange card  
Split pins  
Pipe cleaners



### Instructions:

1. Cut out an egg shape and a head shape for each child.
2. The children should paint these yellow.
3. Each child then needs to make two handprints with the yellow paint, with their fingers spread out. Cut these out when they are dry, cutting in between the fingers - these are the chick's wings.
4. Help the children to stick eyes and a beak onto the chick's face.
5. Attach the head to the body and the wings to the body using split pins.
6. Help the children to make feet for their chicks, using pipe cleaners or card.
7. The chick can either be hung up, by making a small loop at the back of its head with a pipe cleaner or a loop of wool, or by attaching a piece of card to its back so that it will stand up like a card.
8. An Easter message can be written on the front or the back of the chick.
