

Judaism — Hanukkah



To make a dreidel

You will need:

Dreidel pattern

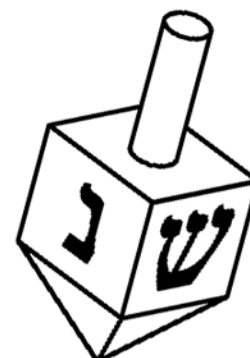
Colouring pens or pencils

A piece of thin card, such as an old cereal packet

Scissors or craft knife

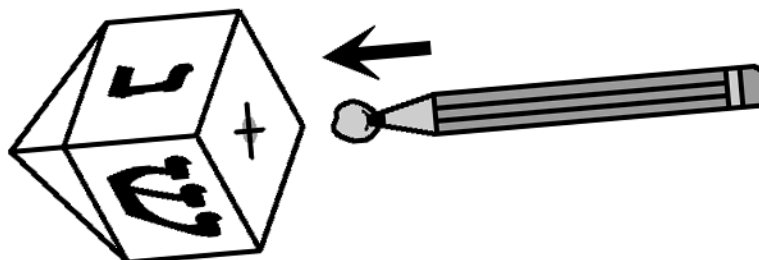
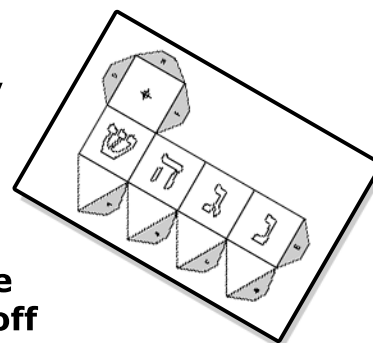
Water-based glue

A pencil for the handle



Instructions:

1. **Colour in the dreidel pattern and stick it firmly on to a piece of card.**
2. **When the glue is dry, cut out the pattern carefully. Include the small cross in the centre of the blank square. Make sure you don't cut off any of the tabs!**
3. **Gently score and fold along each of the lines, including the tabs. Now you are ready to begin sticking.**
4. **Starting with tab A, glue and stick each tab on the inside part of the dreidel, so it will not be seen. Hold it firmly to make sure it sticks.**
5. **Following the letters of the alphabet in order, stick down each of the tabs. The last one may be a bit tricky!**
6. **When the glue is dry, attach a little modelling clay to the pointed end of a pencil. Carefully push the pencil through the little cross you cut on the top of the dreidel. Use the modelling clay to secure the end of the pencil.**
