<p>New radio station of the year (launched since September 2004)</p>	<p>In addition to the programme recordings the station should also submit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weekly schedule • Details of most influential programmes in no more than 250 words • Details of circumstances or difficulties that the station has faced in order to succeed and how they measure the impact on their audience in no more than 250 words • Other information to support the entry such as photographs or marketing materials
<p>News journalist of the year</p>	<p>In addition to the programme recordings the journalist should also submit in no more than 250 words:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A summary the news story covered • Explain why their coverage was of particular significance • Highlight any difficulties faced in order to report the story in a balanced and impartial manner
<p>Sports journalist of the year</p>	<p>In addition to the programme recordings the journalist should also submit in no more than 250 words:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A summary of their approach to sport • Why their coverage was of particular significance • Highlight any difficulties faced to produce their programme(s)
<p>Local on-air campaign of the year</p>	<p>In addition to the programme recordings the station should also submit in no more than 250 words:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A summary of the social campaign or initiative • Why their coverage was of particular significance • Highlight any difficulties faced to produce their programme(s) • Also to be included if available are press clippings of media coverage of the campaign
<p>Talk/interactive show of the year</p>	<p>In addition to the programme recordings the station should also submit in no more than 250 words:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A summary of the most popular topics covered in the last 12 months • Why their programme is of particular significance • Highlight any difficulties faced to produce their programme(s)
<p>Young Broadcaster of the Year (entrants must be 20 years of age or under on 31 December 2006)</p>	<p>In addition to the programme recordings the journalist should also submit in no more than 250 words:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A summary of why they decided to work in radio, what first attracted them to it, what they hope to achieve in their career, and highlight any obstacles they have faced in starting their career • They must provide some form of proof that they are 20 years old or under on 31 December
