A. CONTRIBUTORS AND CONTENT

The story begins in the sewers of London where two surveyors, Bill and David, are inspecting the sewer walls. David disappears into the darkness, - leaving Bill alone. He is attacked by an unknown creature. In the Tardis the Doctor is repairing the chameleon circuit. Peri thinks he is unstable due to his recent regeneration. They hear a distress call coming from Earth - Doctor wants to land and investigate. In a garage back on earth a gang of crooks - Lytton, Griffiths, Russell and Payne, plan to rob a diamond merchants by entering the garage pit and making their way along the sewers to the foundations of the diamond building. With the help of his tracking device the Doctor discovers that the distress call originated in the London garage. After materialising there they are attacked by two Policemen and the Doctor realises something fishy is going on. Doctor & Peri enter the sewers through the garage pit to investigate. Lytton and his gang never get the diamonds because Lytton and Griffiths are captured by Cybermen; Payne is killed and Russell escapes. Lytton we discover has known of the Cybermen's existence all along and wants to serve them and meet the Cyber Controller on the planet Telos. The Cybermen will leave earth with their captives in the Doctor's Tardis. On Telos, Bates and Stratton, captives of the Cyber Controller, plan their escape from the planet, - they will enter Cyber Control disguised as prisoner and escort, and recapture their time-vessel. Back in the sewers Doctor & Peri meet Russell, hear of Lytton and realise the Cybermen have returned. They retreat to the Tardis. The Cyber Leader and Co. are lying in wait, - Russell is killed, and the episode ends with the Leader ordering Peri's destruction.

#### A. CONTRIBUTORS AND CONTENT

The Doctor & Peri have been captured by the Cybermen and are on their way to Telos in the Tardis along with Griffiths and Lytton - whom the Doctor thinks is a mercenary working for the Cybermen. The Cyber Controller awaits their arrival. When they arrive Peri escapes and is saved from attacking Cybermen by the Cryons, Rost & Varne. They are members of a female race who are planning to prevent the Cybermen from leaving Telos, - because when they leave they will destroy it. They also intend to destroy earth. Lytton and Griffiths also escape and meet the Cryon Threst. We learn that Lytton tricked the Cybermen into bringing him to Telos so that he could meet the Cryons and help them in their plan to capture the Cybermen's time-vessel and therefore prevent them from leaving Telos. Lytton needs more men to do this and on the surface of Telos Griffiths and him meet up with Bates and Stratton. The four of them enter Cyber Control and head towards the time-vessel landing pad. They fail, - Bates, Griffiths and Stratton are killed, and Lytton is captured by the Cybermen.

In the meantime, the Doctor has been imprisoned with an older Cryon, Flast. She tells him of the Cybermen's plan. He must escape and prevent the Tardis from being captured. Leaving Flast with his sonic lance which will explode the vastial powder and annihilate Cyber Control, the Doctor escapes and heads towards the Tardis. There he meets Peri and the Cryons. Following a battles, the Cybermen guarding the Tardis and Varne are killed, but the Tardis is safe. The Doctor learns that Lytton was helping the Cryons and they must save him from the Cybermen. They find him in the Cyber Laboratory being cybernised. The Cyber Controller, Leader and Lieutenant return. In the ensuing battle Lytton is killed and the Doctor destroys the Cybermen. Peri leads him back to the Tardis. The vastial finally explodes and Cyber Control is destroyed. The Doctor is depressed because he misjudged Lytton, - he was a friend of the Cryons not the Cybermen.
