A. CONTRIBUTORS AND CONTENT

Turlough (the Doctor's new companion-to-be) is recruited by the Black Guardian to destroy the Doctor. By travelling in a transmatt capsule from Earth he meets The Doctor, Tegan and Nyssa on board a ship that is in perpetual orbit.

A signal from Earth is preventing the Tardis from leaving the ship, so The Doctor and Turlough transmatt, via the capsule, to Earth. The Doctor locates the box that is sending the signal and tries to break its seal. The Black Guardian orders Turlough to kill the Doctor and unseen he picks up a large stone, raising it above his head ready to bring down on the Doctor.

A. CONTRIBUTORS AND CONTENT

Just as Turlough is about to strike the Doctor, the bronze box explodes and he is thrown off balance. The Tardis, instead of landing in 1983 with the Doctor, materialises in the same place but in 1977.

Nyssa and Tegan while exploring the hill see the capsule materialise. Inside they find the charred body of Mawdryn whom they mistake for The Doctor. Tegan goes to find help and returns with Brigadier Lethbridge Stewart who is an old friend of the Doctor. Tegan realises they have landed in the wrong time zone. The girls are frightened by Mawdryn's continually changing features.

Meanwhile, Turlough's friend Ibbotson and teacher (the same Brigadier Lethbridge Stewart only six years older) meet the Doctor. The Brigadier is suffering from loss of memory and doesn't recognise the Doctor. The Doctor thinks this might be related to his losing his Tardis. The Doctor triggers off a reaction that brings part of the Brigadier's memory back.
