- Opens with people running out of a warehouse and being shot by Lytton and his two PCs - Lytton and bodies then mysteriously disappear, watched fearfully by Galloway and Stien who then enter a warehouse where Galloway is shot. The Doctor with Tegan and Turlough arrive on Earth and they too enter the warehouse, where the army is stationed: then Turlough disappears.

In the meantime, a dilapidated Space Station is attacked by a Space Ship on board the Space Station is a prisoner - Davros. The invaders successfully overtake the Bridge of the Space Station killing many Crewmembers; Lytton orders his troopers to release the prisoner.

While this is happening, a Dalek travels down the Time Corridor and reveals himself to the Doctor and his group in the warehouse - and after a fight, the Doctor successfully ejects the Dalek, which explodes.

In the Space Ship the Daleks are making duplicates of their victims which includes Archer and company, in order to overtake the Universe - but Davros has plans of his own, like the capture and duplication of the Doctor. Stien is revealed as a Dalek agent .....

- A. The Doctor is now a prisoner on board the Dalek Space Ship - he must first be processed before being killed. Tegan and Laird are prisoners of duplicated Archer + co in the warehouse; and on the Space Station, Turlough is trying to find a way of escape with Mercer and Styles.

In the meantime, Davros is building up his own army so that under his control the Daleks will once more become triumphant. However, while the Doctor is being processed, a weakness begins to show in Stien's character ....

Then Turlough finds Tegan by the Time Corridor and they go in search of the Doctor. With Stien's help, the Doctor escapes and goes to kill the evil Davros. But Stien gets wounded and the Doctor goes to his aid.

Davros meantime orders the Movellan Virus - fatal to Daleks - to be released in the Dalek ship: while the Supreme Dalek plots to exterminate Davros and his Daleks.

In the final showdown, the Daleks kill each other and Davros discovers that even he is not immune from the fatal virus. Stien succeeds in blowing up both the Space Ship and the Space Station, before dying himself; and the Doctor, Turlough and Tegan escape to Earth. However, Tegan has had enough of space travel and sadly says goodbye to the Doctor.
